

Your Workbook — Read Me First

This pack is the working half of the book. Every lesson ends with a build prompt; the templates here are where that work lives. By the final module, this workbook is your business in document form: your services, your pricing, your policies, your systems.

How to use it

Copy before you write. These templates are shared view-only. In Google Docs or Sheets, choose File → Make a copy, and save your copy into your own drive — ideally the dedicated business account you will set up in Module 10.

Work in lesson order. Each template names its lesson and says where its output goes next. The pieces chain: what you write in Part 1 gets tested in Part 5, priced in Part 9, and sold in Part 15.

One template, one deliverable. If a template feels too big to finish, that is a signal worth noting — the lesson it belongs to explains the decision it asks for.

The one rule: pencil, not ink

Every entry here is a working draft. Later lessons add information that earlier decisions could not account for, and you will revise — that is the design, not a setback. Each template ends with a revision log; a filled-in log is progress you can see.
